## The 24-Hour Knight

- ❑ 12 hours a year reading the weekly parish bulletin, the state and local council newsletters, *Columbia* magazine, and surfing the state council and Supreme Council Web sites.
- ❑ 2 hours a year volunteering at the council's annual drive for people with intellectual disabilities.
- ❑ 2 hours a year attending, with his family, two corporate Communion or council prayer services at his parish.
- ❑ 2 hours a year on a council-sponsored Church, community, council, family or youth project of his choosing.
- ❑ 2 hours a year attending one council meeting.
- ❑ 4 hours a year enjoying (again, with his entire family) a council social function such as a dinner, dance, picnic, etc.

**That's only 24 hours a year**, which practically any man can fit into his schedule. There are 8,760 hours in a year. By giving the Knights of Columbus 24 of those hours (less than .3 percent), a man can be a better Catholic, a better father, a better husband and a better person. Think of the difference the Knights of Columbus can make in our communities if these men join us.
